Eligibility Requirements:

The Committee consists of a chairman, the last three Past Chairmen of the Association available to serve and one Chapter Chairman who served in that office during the previous year from each of the Association's regions chosen by each region. The Immediate Past National Chairman serves as chairman of the Committee.

Scope: The Committee requests and receives from chapters the names of candidates for office in the consult with current officers regarding their willingness to serve. The Committee also certifies all nominees for elected National office prior to their presentation to the National Board of Directors, serving as the Board of Electors, for consideration.
